

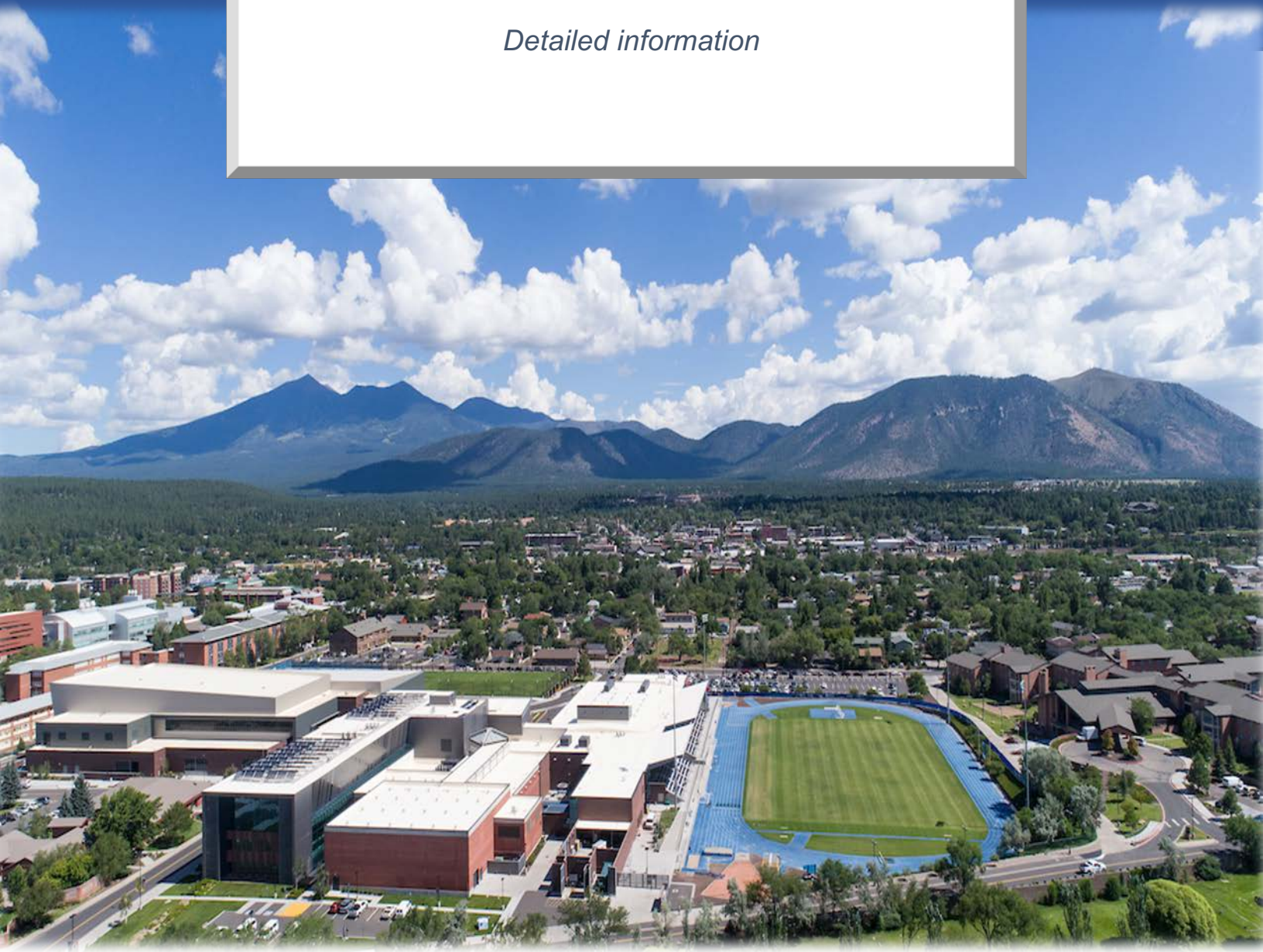

NAU Package Rates for Summer 2023 for Calderon Hall:

Double Room Night Package: \$66.50 including tax per person per night for shared rooms (2 persons per room, shared bathrooms) Package includes room night in designated residence hall and one breakfast, lunch, and dinner per person per room night and planning services.

Single Room Night Package: \$79.49 including tax per person per night for single rooms (1 person per room, shared bathrooms) Package includes room night in designated residence hall and one breakfast, lunch, and dinner per person per room night and planning services.

Complimentary boxed meals are available for days spent off campus when package is purchased.

Meal Times:

Breakfast 7:00am to 9:00am, Lunch 11:30am to 1:30pm, Dinner 4:30pm to 6:30pm.

Lodging Only Rates for Summer 2023 for Calderon Hall:

Lodging Only - Double Room: \$35.23 including tax per person per night for shared rooms (2 persons per room, shared bathrooms) Package includes room night in designated residence hall. No meals included.

Lodging Only - Single Room: \$48.22 including tax per person per night for single rooms (1 person per room, shared bathrooms) Package includes room night in designated residence hall. No meals included.

NAU Dining Services holds an exclusive contract for food service on campus. No food or beverages may be brought in from the outside to be consumed at NAUCC.

Linen Packages for Summer 2023:

Ernest Calderon Hall is a suite style hall that has a convenient central location near the hub of NAU and central quad and offers incredible view of the San Francisco Peaks.

Hall Features

- Two classrooms on first floor available to rent

Parking

Parking permits are required on campus. Parking for personal vehicles is \$5.00/car/day. Parking for busses is \$10.00/bus/day. Buses must park in designated lots. Detached trailers require a permit at \$5.00/trailer/day and must be parked in designated lots. Trailers attached to a personal vehicle will require a pass of \$10.00/permit/day and need to park in designated lots. Charges of \$3.00 per hour will apply for parents dropping off their camper.
